tention to reside permanently in the UNITED STATES, and to renounce for-

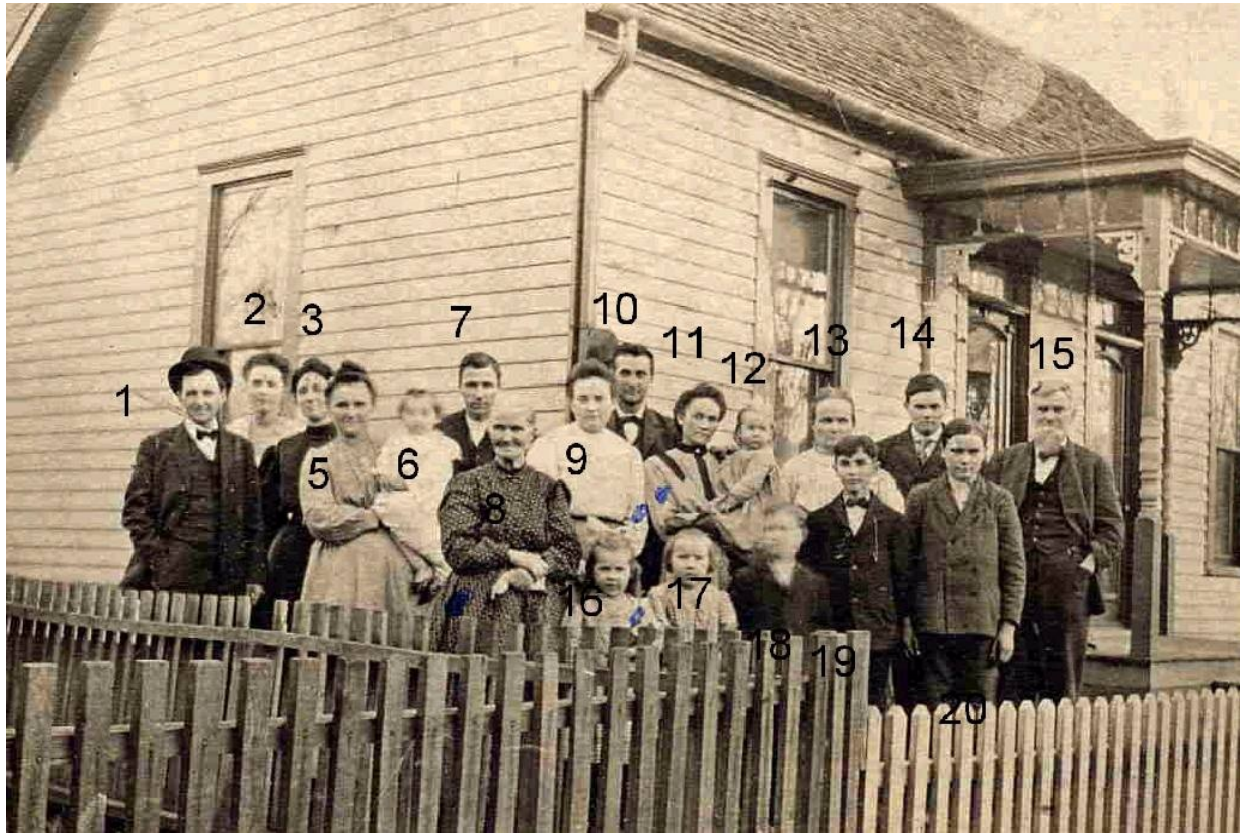
ever ALL ALLEGIANCE AND FIDELITY to any Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sov-

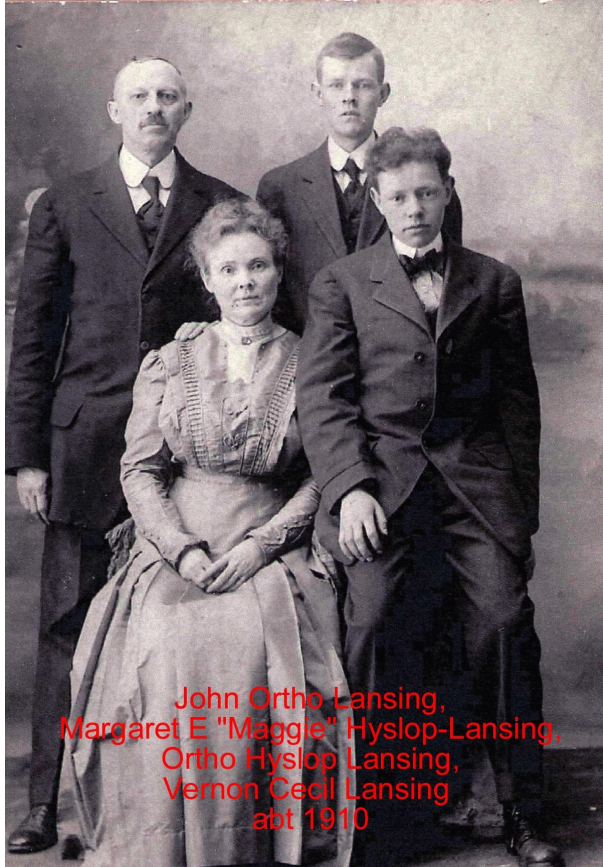

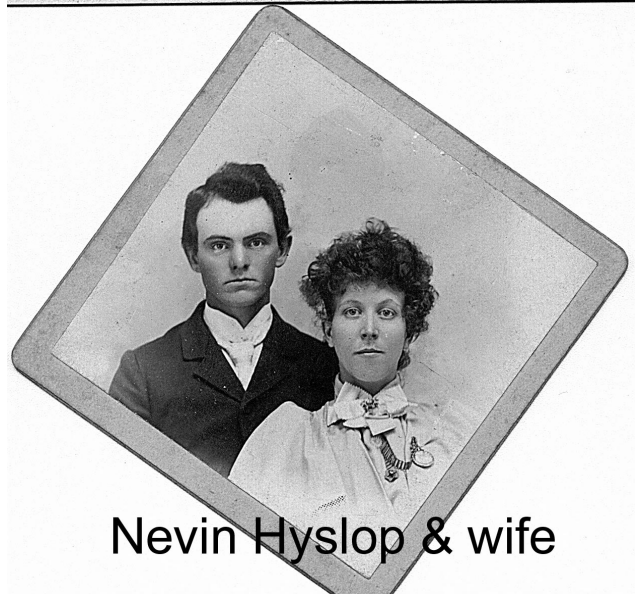
