

Freddie, the three week old son of John Farber and wife of West Main Street died very suddenly Wednesday morning while the parents were eating breakfast. The child had been awake at 6 o'clock, but a little while later when a visit was paid to its crib the babe was dead. Coroner Brokaw was notified, but did not think it necessary to hold an inquest.

After a short service at the home Thursday, conducted by Rev. Sunderman, the remains were taken to Antioch for burial.
