

Isaac N. Frazee was born in Miami County, Ohio, January 4, 1839; departed this life August 29, 1892, aged 53 years, 7 months and 25 days. He moved to Jay County, Indiana in the year 1847, where he has since resided.

He enlisted in the Union Army in the 19th IN Vol. Infantry. In the year 1861, he was discharged there from, and reenlisted in Co. H, IN Vol. Infantry and was mustered out as Captain in 1865. He was a good soldier and loved by his comrades.

About three years ago, he united with the M.D. Church at Antioch. He was married to Ruth Cox, May 19, 1864, who died Nov. 23, 1886. To this union was born seven children. A daughter and companion have gone before. One sister, the surviving children, several relatives and many friends are left to mourn their loss.

The funeral services were held at the Antioch M. C. Church Tuesday August 30, and the remains interred in Antioch Cemetery.
