

STROKE FATAL TO MRS. NORA CRANOR

Mrs. Nora Cranor, 81, residing six miles West of Portland in Greene Township, died Thursday night at 10:30 o'clock at the Jay County Hospital. She suffered a stroke three weeks ago.
