Edwin Hudson, son of Joshua and Mary Hudson, was born in Franklin County, Ohio December 18, 1828, and died July 5, 1897; aged 68 years, 6 months and 17 days. In 1833, he came with his parents to Randolph County, Indiana, and in 1834 to Jay County, Indiana, where he has lived ever since. December 8, 1850, he was united in marriage to Sarah Geiger, daughter of John and Ruth Geiger; to this union there was born 8 children, 6 of whom survive. He was mustered into the service of the U.S. December 1, 1864, as a member of Co. F, 59th Regt. Ind. Vol.

He united with the Dunkard Church and always lived up to his faith, and when death came it found him ready and willing to go.

His funeral was preached in the Dunkard Church July 6, 1897, by the Rev. Yountz of Eaton, Indiana and his remains were laid to rest in the Claycomb graveyard in Greene township. He was a good husband, a kind parent, a good neighbor and an honest man. He rests in peace and hope of the resurrection of the dead who die in the lord.
