

The following was copied from a hand written sheet of paper left in the family bible of Edwin and Sarah Hudson. The bible now belongs to Warren Hudson, RR2, Portland, IN 47371.

Sarah Geiger, daughter of John and Ruth Geiger was born Oct. 9, 1833 in Licking County Ohio and moved with her parents to Jay County, Indiana in 1841 and settled in the woods on the farm now owned by James Barns in Green township.

When eight years old helped her parents make home in woods. She was married to Edwin Hudson on Dec. 8, 1850 and to this union was born seven sons and one daughter of which two sons preceded her to the land beyond; William in 1870 and Clinton in 1893, her husband died July 5, 1897.

She was the oldest of a family of six children, all of whom have passed away but one, a brother Jacob.

The departed died Nov. 14, 1911, at her home in Greene township after a lingering illness.

She leaves to morn, her five sons, Joseph, John, George, Iven and Lewis, one daughter Lydia, twenty-eight grandchildren and fourteen great-grandchildren.
