Cledith E. Loy, 72, 104 W. Elm St., Bryant, died Friday at his residence following an extended illness.

He retired in 1993 from Fisher Body in Marion and owned and operated a golf cart service. He also engaged in farming.

Loy was a charter member of the Tri-State Gas Engine and Tractor Association and was a member of the Portland Moose Lodge.

Born Aug. 18, 1929, in Jay County, he was the son of Walter and Lelia (Gibson) Loy. He was married in 1948, to Patsy Spade, who survives.
