William Bailey, a well-known resident of South Portland, passed away Thursday night at 11 o'clock after several weeks illness of brain trouble. For the past 14 years, the deceased conducted a grocery on S. Shanks St. He was born in Ohio and was 71 years old, last January.

A wife, one son and two daughters survive, the names of the latter being Edward Bailey, S. Meridian St., Mrs. Molly, wife of Jesse Strasburg, living 5 miles northwest of the city, and Mrs. Luella, wife of Leander Harshman, residing in Randolph County. Three brothers and two sisters also survived to mourn his departure.

The funeral services will be held from the French church in the city Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, conducted by Rev. T. E. Williams. Interment will follow in Green Park Cemetery.
