Tuesday morning at the home of her parents, corner of Water and Commerce Street. The child was taken ill of the measles Friday and his disease together with a cold caused its death. Not until late Monday afternoon was its condition considered dangerous.

The funeral services were held from the residence Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock in charge of Rev. H. B. Bosworth; interment in Green Park Cemetery.
