Gilbert Bubp, 87, 1438 West 350 South, Portland, died Wednesday at Adams Memorial Hospital in Decatur.

Born in Portland on March 20, 1919, to Fred and Dona (Darby) Bubp, he graduated from Governor I.P. Gray High School.

He married Anna Stults on Aug. 30, 1941. She died on Oct. 9, 2004.

A World War II veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving from 1944 until 1946, he also served in the Navy Reserve from 1946 until 1952.

A founder of the Portland Forge Credit Union, he retired from Teledyne Portland Forge.

He was an environmentalist and member of American Legion Post No. 211.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Mike (Carole) Leonhard and Mrs. Mike (Marilyn) Minch, both of Portland; a sister, Ruth Pontius, Fort Wayne; six grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
