

The funeral of the late Dr. Robert P. Davis took place from the First Christian Church, East Main Street, Monday afternoon, the services beginning at 1:30 o'clock. Rev. L. M. Krider of Auburn, at one time pastor of the Methodist Episcopal Church in this city, and Rev. M. A. Harlan, the present pastor, officiated.

Robert P. Davis was born in Lawrence County, Ohio, November 12, 1836, and died at his home in this city on March 23, 1902, aged 65 years, 4 months and 16 days.

The services were largely attended by members of the Odd Fellows, Knights of Pythias and Grand Army of the Republic orders, led by a band, who braved the inclement weather – as did many others – to accompany the remains of their dead brother to the last resting place beside the body of his companion in Green Park Cemetery.
