performed Saturday at Ball Memorial Hospital failed to reval a cause of death. Results of toxicology tests should be available in the next 10 days to two weeks.

Jay County Coroner Paulette Wagner said that there were no signs of trauma to the

body. Indiana State and Portland police found no signs of foul play at the scene, located near a picnic table on the west side of the park. A passing motorist saw the body, stopped to check for a pulse, and flagged down a Portland police officer driving in the area. Portland police investigator Todd Wickey said this morning that friends of Day's had dropped him off at the park during the early morning hours on Saturday.

Day was born in Portland on Oct. 5, 1977 to Curt Day and Lisa Landess.

Day was boild in Fordana on Oct. 8, 1977 to Cart Day and Lisa Landess.
