

PORTLAND--Memorial services will be conducted Thursday evening at Baird-Freeman Funeral Home here for county educator Mary M. Finch, 69, RR 1, who died Sunday at Jay County Hospital.

Mrs. Finch taught Latin and English at Jay and Randolph County high schools for several years. She had attended Oxford College for Women and graduated from DePauw University in 1927.

She also attended the University of Illinois and served as professor of ancient languages at Knoxville College in Tennessee. She did graduate work at the University of Wisconsin and University of Michigan.
