Memorial services for Elloise Hiatt, 93, Charlottesville, Va., will be held Feb. 25, at the North United Methodist Church in Indianapolis, and burial will be in Green Park Cemetery in Portland.

Hiatt died Jan. 31 after a fall and head injury.

A native of New Middletown, she was married to Ralph Ellis Hiatt in 1940, and he died in 1998.

She was a school teacher in Richmond before the couple moved to Boston, where her husband worked in the MIT Radiation Laboratory on the development of radar, and she continued to teach. The couple moved to Ann Arbor, Mich., where her husband was then professor and director of the radiation laboratory at the University of Michigan.

Surviving are three children, Robert Hiatt, Berkeley, Calif., David Hiatt, Great Falls, Va., and Mrs. David (Jean) Brown, Charlottesville; three brothers; and five grandchildren.

Visitation will be held at the Teague Funeral Home in Charlottesville on Saturday from 2 to 4 p.m.
