## DEATH CLAIMED

# ROBERT HOUSTON

**PASSED AWAY AT HIS HOME  
ON THE SOUTH SIDE AT  
10:45 THIS MORNING.**

**No Funeral Arrangemets Have  
Been Made—Burial Will Be  
at Portland, Ind.**

At 10:45 o'clock this morning occurred the death of Robert Houston at his home on Vernon street, south side, death being due to tuberculosis with which he had been suffering for the past year.

Mr. Houston was born in Portland, Ind., January 17, 1861 where he resided with his parents until about three years ago, then locating in Kokomo and in January of this year came to this city where he has resided until death this morning.

He is survived by his mother, one sister, Mrs. C. D. Bone, of this city; three half sisters, Mrs. Viola D. Smith, of Kokomo; Estella Kiger, of Fort Wayne, and Mrs. Charlotte Barksy, of Kendallville, and one half-brother, S. A. Kiger, of Kokomo.

While no time has been set for the funeral the remains will be taken to Portland for burial.
