Alice R. Young, 88, Richmond, died early Tuesday morning in Reid Hospital, Richmond. She was a Portland native.

Born to Leora P. and Cecelia (Fitzmaurice) Beard on March 28, 1915 in Portland, she was a 1933 graduate of Portland High School.

On July 22, 1934, she married Richard T. James who was Lt. Governor of Indiana from 1944-48. He died in 1965. She then married Dwight Young on Sept. 24, 1966. He survives.

She was a member of Delta Theta Tau; First Presbyterian Church, Richmond; Indianapolis State Assembly Women's Club since 1935; and former member of First Presbyterian Church, Portland.

Other survivors include one son, Richard B. James, Annapolis, Md.; one daughter, Rebecca James, Chatham, N.Y.; two stepsons, John G. Young, Portland, and Thomas H. Young, Nevada City, Calif.; two stepdaughters, Rebecca Young Strohl, Chatauqua, N.Y., and Phyllis J. Young, Kansas City, Mo.; 17 grandchildren; and 26 great-grandchildren.

Services are Friday at 11 a.m. in Green Park Cemetery Chapel with Pastor Scott Solether officiating.
