Susan L. Jaqua Funeral To Be Held Friday

Mrs. Susan L. Jaqua, 89, life-long resident of Portland, died at 3:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the Charles Davis home on West Walnut street, where she was being cared for by Mrs. Davis and other neighbors. In failing health for several months, her condition became critical last Monday.

She was born in Portland on January 2, 1861, the daughter of pioneer residents, Dr. Manuel and Anna Jane (Rich) Reed. At the time of her death she is believed to have been one of the oldest living native residents of Portland.

Surviving is one son, Jean L. Jaqua of Richmond and several cousins.

The body was removed to the Baird funeral home where friends may call and where services will be held at 2 o'clock, Friday afternoon. Rev. Marshall Weaver will officiate with burial in Green Park cemetery.
