

Theresa Lewis Burial Here

Mrs. Theresa Lewis, widow of the late Squire Albert G. Lewis of Portland, died Monday evening at her home in Jackson, Mich., after an illness of several weeks. She was past 98 years of age.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday evening at 7 o'clock at the Bailey funeral home in Jackson and the body will be brought to Portland Thursday morning to the Williamson funeral home where friends may call from 12 o'clock noon until 2 o'clock. Graveside services will be conducted at Green Park cemetery by Rev. Albert E Habgood.

Mrs. Lewis was well known here by the older residents. She resided at 822 South Meridian street for many years. She was born Oct. 29, 1852 at Alliance, O. She was first married to Charles Johnson and Feb 7, 1897 was married to Albert G. Lewis who died in April 1924. She is survived by one son, Olin M. Johnson, retired mail carrier of Portland; one daughter, Mrs. Rebecca Yowells? of Jackson, Mich., who will be remembered here as Rebecca Wood who was the domestic science teacher in the Portland High school for a number of years; two step-daughters, Mrs. Blanche Ashcraft of Portland and Mrs. Mary Allen of Lima, O.; three grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. She was the last and youngest member of her immediate family.
