

RETIRED MINISTER DIES

Benjamin Nelson Longerbone Succumbs Today.

Benjamin Nelson Longerbone, aged 60, a retired ordained minister of the Church of God, died at 8 o'clock this morning at his home, 1430 West Wildwood avenue, of Bright's disease. He had been ill for one year. Mr. Longerbone had lived in this city for the last 21 years, moving here from Portland.
