

Mrs. Cora Renner Dies After Lengthy Illness

Mrs. Cora A. Renner, 73, wife of Clarence F. Renner, died Wednesday at 2:25 p.m. at the family home, 475 W. Votaw Rd., following an extended illness.

Mrs. Renner was born in Darke County, Ohio, June 19, 1876, the daughter of Emanuel & Mary Jane Figel Suman. She was married in 1912 to Clarence F.
