

Sarah W., daughter of Adolphus and Lydia Walrath, and wife of Rev. E. L. Semans, died at the parsonage on Arch Street, in this city, on Sunday morning at 7 o'clock, June 19, 1887. She was born in Parma, Ohio, Nov. 25, 1846 and was 40 years, 6 months, and 25 days old. She moved to Wisconsin with her parents at the age of 8 years. On March 27, 1871, she was married to Rev. E. L. Semans, in Mayomanie, by Rev. T. M. Fullerton and is the mother of four children, two of whom, Gilbert B., and Francis M., died in the early part of the year 1882.
