Walter Sherman, a former resident of the city, died Thursday evening at his home in Muncie, after a short illness. While residing in the city, he conducted the Oak Saloon on N. Meridian St., and at Muncie he was employed as a bartender.

Sherman was about 32 years of age and is survived by a wife and one daughter. He belonged to the Muncie Bartenders Union and was a charter member of the Jay Aerie No. 928 Fraternal Order of Eagles of the city. Both organizations will be in charge of the funeral, which will be held from the East Main Street Christian Church in the city at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon.

The remains will arrive here over the M. & P. Traction Line on the 1:45 o'clock car and are to be taken at once to the church. Interment will follow in Green Park Cemetery.
