

Thomas J. Stanley, of Co. D, enrolled Oct. 20, 1861 in Allen Co., IN, by Capt. Cosgrove as a 3rd Corporal; mustered in Nov. 22, 1861 in Ft. Wayne by Lt Stansbury at age 20. He was 5' 8.50" tall, fair complexion, blue eyes, and light hair. Born Nov. 7, 1841, in Cuyahoga Co., OH, employed as a coach trimmer, single, resident of Ft. Wayne, in Allen Co., IN. Discharged for phthisis pulmonalis (TB) on Mar. 20, 1863 in Louisville, KY, with rank of Private.

Notes: Came to Ft. Wayne 1843. 19" shoulders, slender build. Honorably mentioned by Col. Reed at Ft. Donelson. Married Mary M. Thompson 1869 in Allen Co., IN. He filed Invalid Pension Application to receive Pension Certificate #725598 Nov. 18, 1896, in IN. Resident of Evansville 1880; of Portland, IN, 1891-92; on 1900 Jay Co., IN census with birth place of NY. Died Apr. 16, 1911; buried in Green Park Cemetery, Sec. 8/Lot 27/Range 2 in Portland, Jay Co., IN.
