His record as a loyal and true soldier in the defense of his country is a very brilliant one. He entered the Army August 21, 1868 as a private, Company B, to which he belonged, entered camp at Richmond, Ind., the same day the regiment was designated the 36th Ind. Col. His regiment was involved in many skirmishes and confrontations throughout the south.

He leaves a wife, one daughter and six sons. Two of the children died several years ago.
