

Alfred Thomas died Saturday evening at 10 o'clock at the home of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. John N. Thomas, who reside on the Bradley Farm four miles west of this city.

The deceased had been ill for several months of consumption, but his death was sudden. While seated on the bed, he had a hemorrhage of the lungs, falling to the floor and expiring before aid could reach him.

The deceased was aged twenty-six years, seven months and six days.

The funeral services will be held Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock from the Union Church near Blaine, conducted by Rev. Fred Stovenour.
