

Obituary of Harriett Shaneyfelt Trueblood

Mrs. Harriett Elizabeth Trueblood, 89, 833 E. Water St., Portland, died Wednesday afternoon at the Jay County Hospital. She had been in failing health for several months. Born July 8, 1883 in Jay County, her parents were Daniel and Nancy (Loy) Shaneyfelt. On Aug. 22, 1900, she was married to Thomas Trueblood, who died Nov. 14, 1955.
