

Obituary of (Jesse) Parker Trueblood

Parker Trueblood, aged 70, died Friday morning at 7:45o'clock at the home on South Bridge street following an illness of two years. Mr. Trueblood had been blind for the past eight years. The deceased was a son of Jonathan and Sarah (Bowers) Trueblood, and was born in Blackford county, October 12, 1870. On December 22, 1902, he was married to Minnie Renner, who survives with the following children: Mrs. Opal Gagle, of Portland; Gertrude, wife of Ivan Keith, of Kokomo; Clayton Trueblood, whose address is unknown; and Mrs. William Ertley, of Florida. Three sons are deceased. He is also survived by 16 grandchildren, three brothers, Thomas Trueblood, of Portland; James Trueblood, of Lehigh, Iowa; and Addison Trueblood, of Galt, Iowa; and two sisters, Mrs. Lillie Coulson and Mrs. Walter Metz, both of Portland. The body was removed to the Baird funeral home for preparation and will be returned to the late residence Saturday morning. Funeral services will be conducted Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the United Brethren church. Rev. J.H. Nall will officiate. Internment will be made in Green Park cemetery.
