Byrd Albert Ware, son of Mr. and Mrs. Enoch F. Ware, died at 3 o'clock Thursday afternoon at the home of his parents 5 miles south of the city. Death was due to tuberculosis of the bones. The first symptom of the disease appeared at the left knee joint more than three years ago, during which time its victim has been in continuous sufferer. For the past year, has been confined to his bed.

The deceased was born in this County, August 26, 1884, and was aged 23 years, three days at the time of his death. Besides the parents, the following brothers and sisters survive: Mrs. Blanche Bishop of Terre Haute, Mrs. Grace Mecker of this city, Lee, Inez, Loucille and Lena Ware, who still reside at home.

The funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon from the late residence and internment follows in Green Park Cemetery.
