

Fred W. Wile died at his home on East Water Street at 9:45 Wednesday evening after a four weeks' illness of typhoid-malaria fever.

He was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Wile, East North Street, and was born in Wabash Township on February 22, 1862, making his age 48 years, 7 months and 19 days. He leaves a wife but no children.

For many years past he has conducted a carriage making establishment on East Water Street.

The funeral services were held at the late residence at three o'clock Friday afternoon and were entirely planned by Mr. Wile when he at last realized that all hope for his recovery had passed.

The funeral services were conducted by S. W. Haynes and Judge John M. Smith; the remains were laid to rest in the Green Park Cemetery.
