Robey C. Reff, 77, Redkey, died Monday at Ball Memorial Hospital.

Born in Keystone on Nov. 8, 1927, he was the son of Floyd and Bernice (Booher) Reff.

He was a 1945 graduate of Redkey High School and was employed for more than 40 years by Delco-Remy in Muncie and Anderson as a lab technician.

While at Delco, he was the co-inventor of the Delco Freedom Battery.

A former member of civil defense, he was a member of the Delco Sympathy Club.

Surviving are three daughters, Derinda Needler, Hartford City, Loretta Faucett, Tell City, and Audrey Comstock, Winchester; a brother, Riley Reff, Powers; and five grandchildren.
