

Elwood Hiatt, residing four miles southwest of the city, at what is known as Elm Grove, died Tuesday at 11:10 of stomach trouble. His funeral takes place Thursday, interment at Camden/Pennville. The deceased leaves a widow and six children.

Mr. Hiatt was born near Linsville, Randolph County, May 22, 1841 and during the same year his parents moved to Green Township, Jay County.

He had lived in Jay County all of his life, except that spent in the service when he was in Company F of the One-hundred and Fortieth Indiana, and was present at the surrender of General Johnson and his army.
