1867 and died at his home at College Corner, Oct. 24, 1889, aged 22 years, 3 months and 15 days. During his fatal illness, which was typhoid fever, he suffered intensely. He said that in regard to living or dying, he was submissive to the will of the Lord, and that he was ready to go if necessary. The immediate cause of death was heart failure. The funeral sermon was preached in the Liber Church by Rev. Bonnell. He was laid to rest in the Liber Cemetery. Portland Commercial, Jay County, IN: October 31, 1889
