

DEATHS.

Mrs. Phoebe J. (Brandon) Stanton late widow of Dr. D. S. Stanton died Wednesday evening at her home on North Meridian street after a short illness of dysentery. Mrs. Stanton has been failing in health for the past year, but was never in a serious condition until lately. She was among the oldest pioneers of this county.

Phoebe J. Brandon was born October 5, 1827, at Springborough, Warren county, Ohio. She was a daughter of Lewis J. and Asenath Brandon. At the time of her death she was 80 years, 10 months and 28 days of age. In 1848 she was married to Dr. David S. Stanton then a practitioner in Cincinnati. The next year they moved to this county, where she has since continued to reside. To this union were born four children: Dell B. Stanton, of this city; John A. Stanton, of Ridgeville; Mrs. Florence B. Gillum, of this city and Ella Arenath, deceased.

Mrs. Stanton is the last of four sisters. Dr. Stanton preceded his wife to the Spirit World on August 21, 1906.

The funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the West Walnut Street Church of Christ, of which she was a member. The services will be conducted by Rev. W. E. McCarty, and interment will be in the Liber cemetery.
