

Alice Havens, 58, RR 2, Portland, in Jackson Township, was found dead at her home Monday evening.

Havens died of a single gunshot wound which was self-inflicted last week, Jay County Sheriff Kip Robinette said today. Robinette said the incident likely occurred on Tuesday, July 28, adding that a neighbor heard a gunshot that afternoon, but thought someone was just shooting in nearby woods.

Born September 2, 1933, in Jay County, she was the daughter of George and Mary Jane (Landwich) Teegarden. She had worked at Sheller-Globe in Portland and was a member of the Women of the Moose.

Surviving are two sons, Mike Havens, Chesapeake, Va., and Chris Havens, Key Largo, Fla.

Graveside services will be held Saturday at 10 am at the Little Salamonina Cemetery with Pastor Kris McPherson officiating.
