

## Lloyd McLaughlin Dies In Ft. Wayne Of Heart Attack

Death has parted the McLaughlin twins at Collett.

Lloyd McLaughlin, 22 died yesterday in Ft. Wayne of a heart attack while visiting at the home of relatives.

He and his brother, Lowell, were almost inseparable.

The son of Mr. and Mrs. Russell McLaughlin, Lloyd had been suffering from a two-day siege of asthma, which brought on the attack.

His mother, the former Miss Neva Ashley, is the Collett correspondent for the Portland Daily Sun and The Commercial Review.

Mr. McLaughlin, a graduate of the Portland High School with the class of '44, was an honor student in engineering at the University of Cincinnati for the past 3 years and was recently assigned "on the job training" as a test engineer at the Ft. Wayne General Electric.

Besides the parents, he is survived by a twin brother, Lowell McLaughlin, also a student in engineering; two sisters, Mrs. Joseph Wheeler, east of Geneva and Alice E. McLaughlin of Colorado Springs, Col.

The body was removed to the Baird Funeral Home where friends may call.

Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday at 2 p.m. from the Little Salamonia Church with the Rev. Paul Logan officiating. Interment will follow in the churchyard.

The body will remain at Baird's until the hour of the funeral.
