A Sudden Death.

Peter Moneysmith, of Noble township, one of the pioneers of Jay county, and a prominent and well known citizen, died at his home seven miles from this city, at 7 o'clock Sunday morning. He arose feeling as well as usual, with the exception of the infirmities which come to old age, but was seized with an attack of heart disease and passed away in fifteen minutes.

Mr. Moneysmith was born in Pennsylvania January 13, 1816, and then moved with his parents to Ohio. He was married to Sarah Booth in 1841, and twenty-two years later moved to Noble township. He leaves a widow and one son, Cyrus Moneysmith.

The funeral will take place tomorrow at 11 o'clock at the U. B church and will be conducted by Revs. Coats and Lusk; interment at Mt. Zion. Baird & Drake are undertakers.
