

Benjamin Miller was born in Fairfield County, Ohio in 1836 and died in Jay County on March 25, 1894, aged 57 years, 10 months and 2 days.

He came to Darke County in 1855; in 1858, was joined by wedlock to Phoebe Clawson and in 1871 came with his wife and children to Jay County, and settled on the farm where he resided until his death.

He leaves a wife and nine children, two sisters and one brother, besides many grandchildren and many friends to mourn their loss.
