Vernum Arlow, son of William and Elizabeth Freemyer, died August 31, 1892 after a brief illness. He leaves a father, mother, three sisters, two brothers, and many relatives to mourn his early death. He was so bright and cheerful that we almost forgot his was mortal. But however dear to us, God saw fit to call him from his world of sorrow to sing with the angels in heaven. Funeral services were conducted by Revs. Jackson and Stovenour.
