

OBITUARY:

"Ethel May Franks, 25, wife of Eugene Franks, residing 7 miles northeast of Portland, died at the home, death being caused from a year and a half's illness of tuberculosis. Mrs. Franks was born August 30, 1906 in Jay county, the daughter of J. R. and Nellie A. Shreeves (sic) Platt. At the time of death she was 25 years, 4 months and 12 days of age. Se was married April 20, 1929 to Eugene Franks, who survives, with an infant son, Robert Harvey, 8 months of age. One child died in infancy. Brothers and sisters surviving are Charles Platt of Madison, Daniel(David) M. Platt of Holland, Mich., Thelma, Ray, Edna, Norma, Martin, Mary Catharine, Virgil, Mabel Jane and June Marea (sic), all at the home of the parents who live southwest of Portland. Services were at the Mt. Zion church, with burial at Salamonia."
