

LeRoy Hudson, 49, Dies Suddenly At Indianapolis

LeRoy R. Hudson, 49, former Jay County resident, died suddenly at his home in Indianapolis Wednesday night. Mr. Hudson had visited relatives near Portland last Sunday.

Born in Jay County on October 18, 1900, he was the son of Oliver and Charlotte (Renbarger) Hudson. In 1921 he was married to Nina Rantz and moved to Indianapolis, where he had been employed as an automobile mechanic. The death of Mrs. Hudson occurred Sept. 25, 1948.

In June, 1949, he was married to Mrs. Sherrill Adams, who survives with a son, Donald Hudson, of LaFayette and a daughter, Mrs. Nilah Jean Armstrong, of Detroit; a granddaughter, Elizabeth; mother, Mrs. Oliver Hudson, and sister, Lucile Hudson, of near Portland. Mr. Hudson was a member of the Indianapolis Masonic Lodge.
