Jetter was taken by Careflight from the scene to Parkview Hospital. Mock complained of pain to his entire body.

There was \$5,000 to \$10,000 damage to Jetter's 1991 Buick and to Mock's 2001 Ford pick-up truck.

Arrangements for Jetter are pending at the Portland Chapel of the Williamson and Spencer Funeral Home.
