Dale M. Manor, 88, 1237 West 450 South, Portland (Collett), died Friday evening in the Parkview Hospital in Fort Wayne following a brief illness.

Born on Feb. 25, 1916 in Jay County, he was the son of Mont and Josie (Lamb) Manor. He married Juanita Reynolds on April 23, 1938. She survives.
