Cletus L. Moore, age 92, a resident of Portland, Indiana, passed away Monday, April 06, 2015, at Persimmon Ridge Rehab Center in Portland.

Cletus was born on February 22, 1923, in Darke County, Ohio, the son of Albert and Orpha (Money) Moore. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Force during World War II from 1941 to 1946; returning from the war to farm and have a long career with Sheller Globe before retiring in 1982. Cletus enjoyed outdoor activities and was a shooting and firearm restoration enthusiast.

He was married to Waveline Johnson for 65 years before her passing in August, 2009. Cletus and Waveline dedicated their lives to their daughter Judy and were founding members of what became Jay Randolph Developmental Services (JRDS).
