

Ashley A. Muhlenkamp, 16, RR 6, Portland, died Saturday morning at Parkview Hospital, Fort Wayne, from injuries suffered in a truck accident on June 12.

Muhlenkamp was a passenger in a Toyota truck that overturned in a ditch on county road 163, south of county road 80 about midnight on Saturday, June 12. The truck was driven by Eric E. Muhlenkamp, 17, 615 E. Main St., Portland. The driver and four other passengers were treated for injuries following the accident.

Active in farming, Muhlenkamp would have been a junior this fall at Jay County High School, where he was a member of the Future Farmers of America.

Born April 15, 1977, in Bluffton, he was the son of Roger and Linda (Shawyer) Muhlenkamp. Surviving in addition to his parents; one brother, Douglas Muhlenkamp, at home; one sister, Angela Anthony, Portland; paternal grandparents, Victor and Mary Agnes Muhlenkamp, Versailles, Ohio; maternal grandmother, June Shawver, Pennville; maternal grandfather, Russell Shawver, Portland; several aunts and uncles, and one niece.

Services are set for 10 am Tuesday in the Baird-Freeman Funeral Home, Portland, with Rev. Mike Harris officiating. Burial will be in the Salamonia Cemetery.
