

[Charles L Platt was] "a member of Asbury United Methodist church in Portland, he also belonged to the F & AM Lodge 36 in Greensburg for more than 50 years, the Order of the Eastern Star Lodge 147 in Greensburg for more than 50 years, the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite Valley of Fort Wayne, the Grand Chapter of the Indiana Royal Arch Masons for more than 50 years, the Mizpah Temple Shrine of Fort Wayne, and the York Rite in Greensburg for more than 50 years. He was also a member of the {K of P) of Portland and a life member of the Elks Lodge 768 of Portland. Burial was in the Salamoniam Cemetery."
