

Martin Shaneyfelt Of Bluff Point Dies Late Monday

Martin Shaneyfelt, 93, of Bluff Point, died at 9:25 p.m. Monday at the home of his daughter Mrs. Harry Martin, at Bluff Point. Mr. Shaneyfelt, a retired farmer and laborer, had been in failing health for nine months.
