Consumption claimed another victim Sunday afternoon at 4 o'clock, when John Garth Stewart, only son of R. P. Stewart, passed away at the home of his father on W. Walnut St.

He had been in failing health for the past six months or more, but was not confined to his home until within the past two weeks.

He attended the Portland High School, being a member of the third-year class, but was compelled to give up his studies the latter part of March owing to his ill health.

The deceased was born in the city March 28, 1890 and at the time of death was aged 17 years and eight days. His father and one sister, Beryl, survived, his mother having preceded him in death six years ago.

The funeral was held Tuesday afternoon at 1 o'clock from the First Church of Christ, in charge of Rev. R. O. Rogers. Interment followed in the cemetery at Salamonia.
