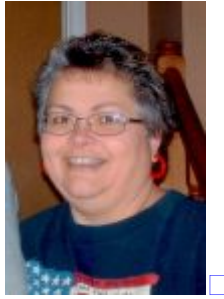


Rinada A. Davis
