LOCAL WOMAN'S FATHER IS DEAD

Dr. H. J. Hiestand, 78, a retired Pennville physician and father of Mrs. J. L. Larmore of Anderson, died Wednesday morning at his home in Pennville.

Dr. Hiestand had practiced medicine for more than 50 years in Pennville. He also was president of the Pennville State Bank. He graduated from what is now the Indiana University School of Medicine in 1906 and began his practice at Pennville in 1907 after a year of internship. He retired in 1957.
