

## Cold Tablets Cause Death Of Young Girl

Gloria Jean Williams, sixteen-month-old daughter of Charles D. and Carlene Pattison Williams of Pennville, died Wednesday evening at 5:50 o'clock at the Bluffton clinic. The little girl swallowed an excessive number of cold tablets which she secured when she climbed up on a table at the Williams home.
